

Report on Clean Up the World 2016

1. Clean Up the World is a global environmental campaign supported by the United Nations Environment Programme to inspire and empower communities to clean up and conserve their environment. Clean Up the World is celebrated every year during the third weekend of September. This year's Clean Up the World Weekend was held from 16-18 September with the theme "**Our Place. Our Planet. Our Responsibility**".
2. Clean Up the World encourages people to show their commitment to improve the environment. It is estimated that about 35 million of people in 130 countries are engaged in Clean Up the World every year making it one of the largest community based environmental campaigns in the world.
3. To mark the above event in Mauritius, this Ministry:
 - has invited all Local Authorities, private sectors, and NGOs to participate fully in the clean up the campaign;
 - has sensitized the public at large to undertake cleanup activities in their surrounding through a radio spot. The radio spot was aired on radio channels of Radio one, Radio plus, Top FM and MBC radio on 22, 23 and 24 September 2016; and
 - has acted as facilitator for carrying out of the cleanup activities.
4. In general, there have been good responses from local authorities, private sector (hotel sector in particular) and NGOs for the Clean Up the World 2016 campaign.
5. Local authorities have organised bulky wastes collection in the towns or villages under their jurisdiction during the third week of September 2016. (The activities undertaken by the different Local Authorities are at Annex 1).
6. Société Rouillard Frères and some 15 hotels have participated in the clean-up of 'Foret Daruty', the beaches and roadsides near their hotels respectively. (The detailed activities undertaken are at Annex 2).

7. Four NGO's fully participated in the clean-up activities, namely ELI Africa, M- Kids Organisation, FORENA and Yes You Can. These NGOs have not only undertaken clean-up activities but were also involved in sensitization of the youth community and the population in general to instill a culture of environmental stewardship. (The activities undertaken by the different NGOs are at Annex 3).
