

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF BID EVALUATION REPORT

Project Title: Coastal Protection, Landscaping and Infrastructural Works at Petit Sable – Bambous Virieux Site

Reference number of procurement: CPB/43/2020

1. Scope of Contract:

The works consist of:

- (i) Fill, of average width of 10m from the edge of the existing Coast Road extending up to 12m at certain locations, to the inner edge of the proposed rock revetment that would accommodate generally a cycle track, an approx. 4m wide ledge for landscaping and a pedestrian walkway;
- (ii) About 1.5km of rock revetment between CH00 and CH2000, including the coastal stretch in front of the Pointe du Diable National Heritage Site;
- (iii) Precast mass concrete block alongside the lee side of the revetment crest with a fibre reinforced concrete wall along the stretch in front of the Pointe du Diable battery wall;
- (iv) 2m wide walkway in pervious concrete along the leeside of the precast mass concrete block and crown mass concrete wall;
- (v) 2.5m wide cycle track with asphaltic concrete surfacing from CH 175 to CH 675 approx.;
- (vi) Upgrading of the existing open drain and the construction of a reinforced concrete footbridge at CH115 approx.;
- (vii) A new 1.5m wide footbridge and associated staircases across the Pointe du Diable battery wall at CH740 approx. to link the proposed walkway to the existing upper platform;
- (viii) At the Pointe du Diable battery wall, a lower area filled with calcarenite aggregates of an approx. area of 820m², a paving block platform at a higher level, pedestrian staircases/ramps and retaining walls;
- (ix) Terracing works between CH725 and CH750 to create two, 3m wide platforms for recreational purposes;
- (x) 5 No parking bays;
- (xi) Staircases for pedestrian access to the sea at 6 locations;
- (xii) Mass concrete seawall and staircase at the northern part of site (CH06 to CH21);
- (xiii) Perched beaches (sand pits) at two locations, namely between CH30 and CH85, and between CH725 and CH750 approx.
- (xiv) Low masonry walls along perched beaches (sand pits) and masonry retaining wall along perimeter of existing occupied plot of land at Petit Sable
- (xv) Extension of some 13 No. existing culverts across the proposed works up to the new coastline
- (xvi) Provision of water points, 2 Nos. informative panels and bases of lighting poles
- (xvii) Timber hand railing and barrier; and
- (xviii) Landscaping works comprising grassing and planting of trees.

2. Procurement method used: Open National Bidding Method.

3. Date of Invitation of Bids: 01 December 2020.

4. Closing date for submission of bids: 20 January 2021.

5. Date and place of opening of bids: 20 January 2021 at the Central Procurement Board (CPB), Social Security House, Julius Nyerere Avenue, Rose Hill, Mauritius.

6. Number of bids received by closing date: Six.
