- What are the key determinants of theses outcomes/impacts? (explaining factors?)
- How effective was the project in delevering these impacts/outcomes
- What are the key lessons to draw from the implementation of the experience?
- What aree the key messages (2-3) to the targeted? (
 the message should clearly state what measures or
 actions should be taken to consolidate/mainstream
 lessons and impacts)

THE MOZAMBIQUE MORINGA PROJECT **Objective** To influence decision makers to replicate the project results to other drought-prone areas in Mozambique Ask the Question: Define your criteria and What will be the key indicators determinants for policy makers behavior change Examples of criteria/guiding questions Is the technology Is it environmentally Is it socially acceptable? accessible/affordable to sustainable poor communities? Show evidence of positive **Tools** impact on social **TEES** adaptation DRI Show evidence of **Matrix** constraining factors 4R's
