







Programme Background




- **Government of Japan (GOJ) funded project under its Cool Earth Partnership for Africa Rs 90 M (US \$ 2,987,004)**
- **Mauritius is one of the 20 participating countries**
- **Project Started **January 2010** and ending in **December 2012****
- **UNDP CO is Implementing Agency.**
- **MoESD as lead Exec/ Coord Ministry with Met Services (PMO), MoFED, MoT, MoEd, MAIFS, UoM as Executing Agencies**



Main Objective of AAP Mauritius




To integrate and mainstream climate change adaptation into the institutional framework and into core development policies, strategies and plans for the Republic of Mauritius (Mauritius, Rodrigues, Agalega)




Project Outputs

1. Dynamic, **long-term planning** mechanisms to manage the inherent uncertainties of climate change **introduced (USD 737,004)**
2. **Leadership capacities** and **institutional frameworks** to manage climate change risks and opportunities in an integrated manner at the local and national levels **strengthened (USD 330,000)**
3. **Climate-resilient policies and measures in priority sectors implemented (USD 845, 000)**
4. **Financing options** to meet national adaptation costs **expanded** at the local, national, sub-regional and regional levels **(USD 520,000)**
5. **Knowledge** on adjusting national development processes to fully incorporate climate change risks and opportunities **generated and shared** across all levels **(USD 555,000)**
