

Environment Protection (Declaration of Environmental Laws) Regulations 2005

THE ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT 2002

Regulations made by the Minister under section 96 of the Environment Protection Act 2002

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Environment Protection (Declaration of Environmental Laws) Regulations 2005**.
- 2.** In these regulations -
"Act" means the Environment Protection Act 2002.
- 3.** For the purposes of section 3 of the Act, the enactments specified in the Schedule are declared to be environmental laws.
- 4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 02 May 2005.
Made by the Minister with the approval of the National Environment Commission on 13 April 2005.
