Return on Crackdown Operations (April to July 2024)

Pursuant to the Environment Protection (Control of Single Use Plastic Products) Regulations 2020 and the Environment Protection (Banning of Plastic Bags) Regulations 2020 which became effective as from 15 January 2021 and 01 March 2021 respectively, crackdown operations are carried out jointly by officers of the Ministry of Environment, Solid Waste Management and Climate Change (Environment and Climate Change Division), the Police de l'Environnement and local authorities across the island. Details for the period April to July 2024 are as hereunder:-

A. Operations on Land

60 outlets and stalls visited and 34 contraventions established for non-compliance with the two Regulations as follows:
