

### **Returns on Enforcement of Vehicular Smoke Emissions (March – November 2022)**

Pursuant to the Road Traffic (Control of Vehicle Emissions) (Amendment) Regulations 2022, the return on enforcement of smoke emissions on diesel-driven Government vehicles for the period of March to November 2022 is as follows:
