

**LIST OF CONDITIONS FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE
ARNAUD DAM AND A DIVERSION CANAL ON RIVER DU POSTE AT
ARNAUD BY THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY & PUBLIC
UTILITIES (ENV/DOE/EIA/1589)**

1. All other necessary permits/clearances from the relevant authorities shall be obtained and all the conditions attached therewith shall be scrupulously observed. A copy of all the permits/clearances obtained shall be submitted to the Director of Environment.
2. All land issues shall be sorted out with the Forestry Service of the Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security. The Ministry of Housing and Lands shall be informed after approval has been obtained for the release of the site and a survey plan accordingly submitted for eventual vesting of the site in Ministry of Energy and Public Utilities.
3. The development shall be undertaken as per the mitigating measures stated in the EIA report and in the additional information submitted, unless as otherwise advised herein.
4. The works shall be carried out in strict compliance with the conditions as imposed by the Forestry Service of the Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security in its letter dated 20 June 2012 and bearing reference F.D No.116/7/Vol II.
5. The Department of Environment shall be informed in writing of the date of completion of all works on site, with copy of the as-built layout plan, prior to the start of operation for monitoring purposes and to ensure compliance with the conditions imposed with the approval of the EIA as well as the proposals in the EIA report and additional information.
6. Necessary measures shall be taken to prevent any hydrocarbon spills from vehicles and from the stand-by generator and diesel storage tanks to infiltrate through the soil so as to avoid the contamination of the underground and surface waters.

7. Necessary measures shall be taken during all the phases of the project, including construction and operation so as not to cause any nuisance by way of dust and noise to the public and surrounding environment.
8. The proponent shall, in consultation with the Forestry Services of the Ministry of Agro Industry & Food Security, replant at least twice the number of trees felled by the creation of the Diversion Canal.
9. Any proposed deviation shall be subject to an application to the Director of Environment. No deviation or part thereof shall be executed prior to the determination of the application by the Director.
