

**LIST OF CONDITIONS - proposed Coastal Protection Works  
to control beach erosion in front of Terrain Basset at  
Grand Gaube by Société Jacsyl (ENV/12/1463)**

1. All other necessary permits/clearances from the relevant authorities shall be obtained and all the conditions attached therewith shall be scrupulously observed. A copy of all the permits/clearances obtained shall be submitted to the Director of Environment.
2. The development shall be undertaken as per the mitigating measures stated in the EIA report and the additional information submitted unless as otherwise advised therein.
3. The Department of Environment shall be informed in writing of the date of commencement of works for monitoring purposes. A detailed programme of work and implementation plans shall be submitted to the Department of Environment, Ministry of Environment & S.D and Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division) for approval prior to the start of works. The machinery to be used shall have the prior approval of the Department of Environment, Ministry of Environment & S.D and Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division).
4. In accordance with section 18(2)(l) of the Environment Protection Act 2002, the proponent shall submit to the Director of Environment, with copy to the Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division), an Environmental Monitoring Plan for approval prior to start of works. The proponent shall thereafter submit reports on the implementation accordingly.
5. The Environment Monitoring Plan shall contain the baseline data on the state of the marine environment at the project site. The proponent shall monitor the state of the marine environment including the current patterns after the implementation of the project and shall submit reports on same to the Ministry of Environment & S.D and the Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division) on a regular basis as determined in the approved Environment Monitoring Plan.

6. A beach profile survey and bathymetry shall be undertaken prior to start of works and just after the completion of works, and thereafter on a regular basis as determined in the approved Environment Monitoring Plan. The report on same shall be submitted to the Ministry of Environment & S.D and the Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division)
7. During the implementation of the project, the adjoining sites shall be effectively protected against sediment entrainment with geo-textile screen of appropriate mesh size, installed in double layers in the lagoon and regularly maintained.
8. The proposed wire mesh fence shall not be higher than 1.2m with provision of public access along the beach.
9. No debris or waste of any type shall have access to the sea.
10. There shall be no removal of embedded rocks/boulders and no recourse to any dredging during the coastal improvement works.
11. The sand used for the beach re-profiling shall be of appropriate granulometry.
12. The works shall be undertaken at low tide between sunrise and sunset.
13. The operations shall be interrupted during rough seas or adverse climatic conditions.
14. Any live sedentary organisms shall be hand-picked and transferred from the project site to safer areas in the lagoon prior to start of works. All rubbles that are supportive of live coral shall be manually and carefully displaced in an appropriate locality for their growth.

15. The proponent shall cater for a safe access on the beach. The public shall have free and unrestricted access to the beach at all times.
16. At the start of implementation, necessary measures shall be taken to notify the public of all beach and lagoonal works to be undertaken in the accordance with the scheduled programme of works. The proponent shall erect a sign board on site to inform the public of the presence of boulders in the sea.
17. If during the implementation of the project and during monitoring, any environmental problem or negative impacts ensues, the proponent shall accordingly inform this Ministry and the Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division) immediately.
18. Shall any erosion problem arise on site or offsite, the redress shall come from the proponent and all structures shall have to be removed immediately and the site reinstated to the satisfaction of this Ministry and the Ministry of Fisheries and Rodrigues (Fisheries Division).
19. The promoter shall resolve any conflict that may arise with the fishers and other coastal users prior to, during and after the implementation of the project.
20. Any proposed deviation shall be subject to an application to the Director of Environment. No deviation or part thereof shall be executed prior to the determination of the application by the Director.
