

LIST OF CONDITIONS - the proposed CONSTRUCTION AND
OPERATION OF A CEMENT BLENDING PLANT AT MER ROUGE BY
HOLCIM (MTS) LTD(ENV/DOE/EIA/1528)

1. All other necessary permits/clearances from the relevant authorities including Clearance from Mauritius Port Authority and all the conditions attached therewith shall be scrupulously observed. A copy of all the permits/ clearances obtained shall be submitted to the Director of Environment.
2. The development shall be undertaken as per the mitigating measures stated in the EIA report and the additional information submitted unless as otherwise advised therein.
3. In accordance with section 18 2(1) of the Environment Protection Act 2002, the proponent shall submit to the Director of Environment, an Environmental Monitoring Plan (EMP) for approval prior to start of works. The proponent shall thereafter submit reports on the implementation, accordingly.
4. The standard of the blended cements shall meet the requirements as specified by the Mauritius Standard Bureau. The packaging shall be properly labelled to indicate the composition and application of the blended cement.
5. Necessary measures shall be taken during the construction phase so as not to cause any nuisance by way of noise, odour, vibration and dust pollution to the neighbours, the surrounding environment and the public.
6. Proponent shall ensure that the axle loads of the trucks entering and leaving the plant compound are in conformity with Road Traffic regulations and the ways and methods proposed to respect it.
7. Appropriate measures shall be taken to avoid damage to public roads due to spillage of materials by heavy vehicles on the road surface.

8. The proponent shall make provision of an appropriate means to discharge storm water through mud/slits traps and hydrocarbon separators prior to open discharging to the receiving environment.
9. All wastewater shall be channeled to the existing on-site wastewater disposal system.
10. Solid wastes shall be regularly collected and disposed of as per the recommendations of the Local Authority.
11. Electric motors such as compressors, pumps and other noise generating equipment shall be housed in soundproof structures so that the noise emanating therefrom be within permissible levels as per the Environment Protection (Environment Standards for Noise) Regulations 1997 promulgated under the Environment Protection Act.
12. The operation of the blending plant shall in no way generate dust nuisance during the activities, including the transportation of fly-ash and delivery of products.
13. The proponent shall adopt energy-saving devices and eco-friendly practices such as renewable energy supply (solar energy and photovoltaic cells) and other similar facilities.
14. The Department of Environment shall be informed in writing of the date of completion of all works on site, with copy of the as-built layout plan for monitoring purposes and to ensure compliance with the conditions of the EIA licence as well as the proposals in the EIA report.

15. Any proposed deviation shall be subject to an application to the Director of Environment. No deviation or part thereof shall be executed prior to the determination of the application by the Director.
