

**LIST OF CONDITIONS - PROPOSED EXTENSION OF MARE CHICOSE
LANDFILL - CONSTRUCTION OF SUBCELL 7 BY M/LOCAL
GOVERNMENT & OI [ENV/DOE/EIA/12/1571]**

1. All other necessary permits/clearances, from the relevant authorities including clearance from the Traffic Management & Road Safety Unit shall be obtained and all the conditions attached therewith shall be scrupulously observed. A copy of all the permits/clearances obtained shall be submitted to the Director of Environment.
2. The development shall be undertaken as per the mitigating measures stated in the EIA report unless as otherwise advised herein.
3. A detailed programme of work shall be submitted to the Department of Environment, Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development.
4. In accordance with section 18(2)(l) of the Environment Protection Act 2002, the proponent shall submit to the Director of Environment, an Environmental Monitoring Plan for approval.
5. The Department of Environment shall be informed in writing of the date of completion of all works on site, with copy of the as-built layout plan for monitoring purposes and to ensure compliance with the conditions of the EIA licence as well as the proposals in the EIA report.
6. A contingency plan shall be set up to combat any case of accidental spillage of leachate, operational failure of equipment etc. The contingency plan, as provided for under section 30 (3) (a) of the Environment Protection Act shall be submitted to the Director of Environment prior to operation.
7. Prior to start of operation, the proponent shall submit baseline data on the ground water quality at the monitoring borehole proposed for Sub Cell 7.
8. The proponent shall ensure that monitoring of ground water quality be carried out on a regular basis as agreed by the Ministry of Environment & Sustainable Development and the Ministry of Energy & Public Utilities.

9. All leachate shall be carted away to Roche Bois Pumping Station, until further notice and subject to future regulations. The carting away of leachate shall be carried out by registered wastewater carriers.
10. No waste of any type shall be disposed of or have access directly or indirectly to any water course including the Feeder Donald, Feeder Tibere and River Tranquille.
11. Necessary measures shall be taken to prevent any hydrocarbon spills from vehicles to infiltrate through the soil so as to avoid the contamination of the underground and surface waters.
12. The peripheral water drains shall be regularly maintained to prevent blocking and eventual accumulation of surface water in the drains.
13. Necessary precaution shall be taken to ensure that mud and other contaminants from all vehicles leaving the site do not become part of runoff waters and contaminate any water body or watercourse.
14. The noise level shall be within permissible limits as per the Noise Regulations promulgated under the Environment Protection Act.
15. Appropriate measures shall be taken to abate odour nuisances.
16. Necessary measures shall be taken during construction and operation phase so as not to cause any form of nuisance to the public and surrounding environment.
17. Any proposed deviation shall be subject to an application to the Director of Environment. No deviation or part thereof shall be executed prior to the determination of the application by the Director.
