Failure to register as a designated establishment under the Environment Protection Act by the due date is an offence under the Act. On conviction, the manager is liable to a fine not exceeding 50,000 rupees and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years.

Notes

Use BLOCK LETTERS to fill in items 1, 3 and 4. Leave space between 2 words.

- Item 1 On the first line, enter COMPANY, SOCIETE, SUCCN, MR, MRS, MISS, Dr or Dr (Mrs), as appropriate.
- Where the person is an individual, write the surname on the second line and the other names on the other lines.
- Item 2 If space is not sufficient, attach a separate sheet giving the other trading names.
- Item 3 Number of places of business. Enter the number of sites at which the enterprise or activity operates.
- Item 5 The manager of an enterprise/establishment is the owner or the person having the charge, management or control of the enterprise, activity or undertaking and includes the licensee of the enterprise/establishment.
- Item 6 State whether enterprise/establishment is a hotel, boarding house of more than 4 bedrooms, or is engaged in stone crushing and or in the manufacture or processing of aggregates, concrete blocks, precast units, coral sand, rocksand or basalt sand.
- Item 8 Enter the total annual turnover of the enterprise/establishment in respect of the activities subject to the Environment Protection Fee.
- The total turnover figure should be in respect of the latest accounting year of the enterprise/establishment. In case it is a new business, give an estimate of the annual turnover.

Hotels and boarding houses of more than 4 bedrooms are subject to the Environment Protection Fee on their monthly turnover as from the month of January 2000.

Enterprises engaged in stone crushing and or in the manufacture or processing of aggregates, concrete blocks, precast units, coral sand, rocksand or basalt sand are subject to the Environment Protection Fee on their monthly turnover in respect of these activities as from the month of July 2001.

The law requires every manager of an enterprise/establishment to register the enterprise/establishment as a designated establishment with the Director of Environment.

For hotels and boarding houses in operation before 1 January 2000, the time limit for registration is 31 January 2000.

For enterprises engaged in stone crushing, etc.in operation before 1 July 2001, the time limit for registration is 31 July 2001.

For enterprises/establishments which start their activities on or after 1 January 2000 or 1 July 2001, as appropriate, the time limit for registration is 14 days of the start of the activities.
