**Screening Exercise at Pointe D'Esny**

**Ambient Air Monitoring Exercise using Portable Gas Analyzer in the region of  
Pointe d'Esny and its surroundings following complaint of Odour from oil spill at  
Pointe d'Esny**

Further to complaint of odour from oil spill at Pointe d'Esny, the National Environmental Laboratory of the Ministry of Environment, Solid Waste Management and Climate Change carried out a spot check measurement in the region of Pointe d'Esny and its surroundings areas, on Thursday 08 July 2021 at around 13 15 hrs.

**Monitoring Sites**

The following sites were monitored namely Pointe d'Esny, Blue Bay and Pointe Jérôme Embarkation spot.

The above areas were screened for potential Volatile Organic Compounds that may be present.

**On-site Observations**

- At time of visit, the weather was sunny and there was good wind flushing onsite in a south-easterly direction;
- No odour was present at the points screened; and
- Some nautical activities were seen onsite.

**Findings**

None of the toxic volatile organic compounds screened, at all the sites, were detected at the time of measurement.
